How to Separate

How to Put out

Use the **designated bags** to put out burnable and non burnable garbage.

Write your name, address, telephone number or unit number on the bag with a permanent marker.

Put out garbage **by 8:00 am** on garbage day. (Do not put out garbage the day before.)

## Garbage Collection Calendar for Households

Revised in 2020

### Garbage Site

- Do not put out business or commercial waste.
- Waste that does not comply with these rules will not be taken away.

Prices of designated bags (Burnable/Nonburnable)

- 45g **¥300/set**
- 30g **¥200/set**
- 20g **¥130/set**
- 10g (Nonburnable waste only) **¥70/set**

**Every Tue & Fri**

Garbage will be collected on public holidays. \* Excluding New Year's break

### Burnable Garbage

Guidebook P6 - 7

- Plastic, vinyl
- Kitchen waste \* Drain liquids before bagging.
- Nonrecyclable Paper, Clothing, Fabrics, Boots
- Blankets, Quilts, Cushions (Down quilts can be discarded as burnable garbage if bagged.)
- \* Cut sheets, blankets and quilts into 1 m<sup>2</sup> pieces or smaller.
- Ash
- Cassette tapes, Video tapes, CDs, MDs
- Leaves, Pruned branches (No more than 5 cm in diameter and short enough to fit in bags)
- Shells, etc.



### Nonrecyclable, burnable garbage that fits in the bags

\* Anything too big to fit into bags must be discarded as bulky garbage.

These garbage items can be discarded in any kind of bag.



### Disposable diapers

Remove fecal matter, place in a plastic bag, and write your name or other identifying information on the bag before putting out for collection.

### Pruned branches

- Branches must be no more than 5 cm in diameter each
- 50 cm in length
- 30 cm in diameter when bundled

**Every 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Wed**

Garbage will be collected on public holidays. \* Excluding New Year's break

### Nonburnable Garbage

Guidebook P8

### Nonrecyclable, nonburnable garbage that fits in the bags

\* Anything too big to fit into bags must be discarded as bulky garbage. \* Wrap blades or broken objects in paper, etc. to prevent accidents.

Exception Umbrellas will be collected even if they stick out of the bag.

- Ceramic
- Nonburnable garbage that cannot be separated from burnable garbage
- Mirrors
- Lightbulbs (Fluorescent tubes are harmful garbage.)
- Glass, Glass products
- Broken bottles and fluorescent tubes
- Marbles
- Knives, Cutters, Nails, Scissors
- Aluminum foil, Paper clips
- Disposable heating pads, etc.



**Every 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Wed**

Garbage will be collected on public holidays. \* Excluding New Year's break

### PET Bottles

Guidebook P9 Recyclables

- Do not crush or compact bottles.
- Empty beverage or other plastic bottles bearing the PET 1 mark
- \* Remove labels and contents, and rinse bottles before putting out for collection.



**Every 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Thu**

Garbage will be collected on public holidays. \* Excluding New Year's break

### Cans Metals

Guidebook P10 Recyclables

- Beverage/Food cans
- Up to 18 l in size
- \* Remove contents and rinse cans before putting out for collection.
- \* Remove oil or fuel before putting out for collection.
- Metal pipes/bars no more than 1.5 m in length
- Metal pots/pans
- Cooking appliances
- Gas cooktops
- Kerosene heaters, etc.



### Small Appliances

Guidebook P11 Recyclables

- Small appliances other than 4 kinds of appliances
- Microwave ovens
- Radio cassette players
- Dryers
- Rice cookers
- Computers
- Telephones, Fax machines
- Cellphones, etc.
- \* Dispose of kerosene heaters as metals.
- \* Dispose of Portable cooktops as metals.
- \* Dispose of Electric blankets, electric carpets and dehumidifiers as bulky garbage.
- \* Delete data from computers and cellphones before putting out for collection.



**Every 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Thu**

Garbage will be collected on public holidays. \* Excluding New Year's break

### Paper

Guidebook P12 Recyclables

- \* Bundle and tie waste paper to a cross with paper string before putting out for collection. Dispose of thermal paper as burnable waste.
- [1] Newsprint ... Newspapers, Flyers
- [2] Fiberboard ... Cardboard, Thick paper container, Tissue boxes, etc.
- [3] Miscellaneous paper ... Magazines, Books, Notebooks, Paper carton, Paper other than [1] or [2]



### Bottles

Guidebook P13 Recyclables

- Drink/Food bottles
- Cosmetics bottles
- Oral medicine bottles (White glass bottles qualify as nonburnable garbage.)
- \* Remove contents and rinse glass bottles before putting out for collection.
- \* Dispose of Broken bottles as nonburnable garbage.



### Harmful garbage

Guidebook P14

- Batteries (Alkaline, Manganese, Coin)
- Mercury thermometers
- Fluorescent tubes/bulbs
- \* Dispose of broken items as nonburnable garbage.
- \* Please take recycle rechargeable batteries to a cooperating store (see P14 in the Guidebook).



### Dangerous garbage

Guidebook P15

- Spray cans
- Lighters, CO<sub>2</sub> gas cylinder
- Gas cartridges for portable cooktops
- \* Put out spray cans, cylinders and cartridges without puncturing.



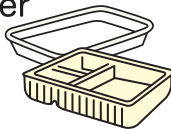

- Bags
- Stuffed dolls, etc.

\* Do not put out these waste items at collection points. \* The Town will not collect them.

### Bulky garbage

Guidebook P19

- Garbage that does not fit into marked bags
- Metal items over 1.5 m in length
- Burnable garbage over 5 cm in thickness
- Furniture
- Quilts
- Mats
- Carpets
- Bicycles
- Wheelchairs
- Dehumidifiers, etc.
- \* Excluding 4 kind of appliances and difficult-to-handle garbage

Appliances specified in Japan's Home Appliance Recycling Act (Act on Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances)

Air Conditioners

TVs

CRT, LCD, Plasm

Refrigerators

Washing Machines

Freezers

Clothes Dryers

What you should do

- Entrust pickup to a reseller.
- Entrust pickup to a waste collector.
- Entrust pickup to an appliance retailer.
- Bring the appliance in yourself.

### Difficult-To-Handle Garbage

Guidebook P22

What is "Difficult-To-Handle Garbage"

- Dangerous garbage that cannot be treated
- Garbage specified in concerned laws and regulations

Examples

- Automotive parts (Batteries, Tires, etc.)
- Powered agricultural tools/ridable machinery (Lawnmowers, 3/4-Wheel vehicles, etc.)
- Petroleum products (Gasoline, Kerosene, Paint, etc.)
- Chemicals (Agrochemicals)
- Other (Fire extinguishers, Propane gas tanks, etc.)
