Nonrecyclable, nonburnable garbage that fits in the bags * Anything too big to fit into bags must be discarded as bulky garbage.

- * Wrap blades or broken objects in paper, etc. to prevent accidents.
- Exception Umbrellas will be collected even if they stick out of the bag.
 - Ceramic
 Nonburnable garbage that cannot be separated from burnable garbage Mirrors
 Lightbulbs (Fluorescent tubes are harmful garbage.)
 Glass, Glass products

* Dispose of kerosene heaters as metals. Dispose of Portable cooktops as metals.

Delete data from computers and cellphones before putting out for collection.

- Broken bottles and fluorescent tubes

 Knives, Cutters, Nails, Scissors
- Aluminum foil, Paper clips
 Disposable heating pads, etc.

What is "Difficult-To-Handle Garbage"

- Dangerous garbage that cannot be treated Garbage specified in concerned laws
- and regulations
