Caregiver Training Course for Foreign Residents

This course is for foreign residents who want to work in caregiving. You will learn the skills and knowledge needed for caregiving work. You will also learn Japanese and workplace manners used on the job. After the course, you can aim to get a job at a care facility.

■ Who can apply?

You must meet all 3 conditions.

You have permanent or long-term resident status in Japan.

You can read and write hiragana and speak simple Japanese.

You have registered with Hello Work to look for a job.

August 5 (Wed) to November 4 (Wed). Classes are Monday to Friday, from 9:10 a.m. to 3:50 p.m. There are no classes on Saturdays, Sundays, or public holidays.

If You Cannot Get Burnable Garbage Bags

If you cannot get the designated burnable garbage bags (green bags), you may use a different bag instead.

Please follow these three rules:

1. Use a clear or semi-transparent bag.
2. Use a bag that is between 20L and 45L in size.
3. Write your name and the same information that you would normally write on the designated garbage bag.

Note: You may only use a different bag until Friday, August 28.
