If You Cannot Get Burnable Garbage Bags

If you cannot get the designated burnable garbage bags (green bags), you can use a different bag instead.

Please follow these 3 rules:

1. Use a clear or semi-transparent bag.
2. Use a bag that is 20L–45L in size.
3. Write your name and other required information on the bag, just as you would on the designated garbage bag.

"Camellia" is a consultation service for foreigners operated by the Shizuoka International Relations Association (SIR).

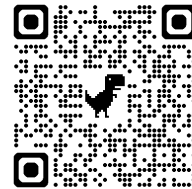
You can get advice on daily life issues such as housing, work, school, healthcare, and residency status.
